Framework legitimacy







Framework ITT honoured all guiding principles of the EU tendering law procured under Dutch tendering law

- ✓ Competition between resellers per lot within the Framework Contract
- ✓ Call of Contracts as result of a mini-competition or direct award between reseller and institute
- ✓ For EC funded projects Voucher Contracts are signed between GÉANT and reseller to be VAT and EC GA compliant
- ✓ Institutions responsible for scoring and awarding decision
- ✓ Direct award possible on conditions
- ✓ CMG supported dashboard in support of mini-competitions
- ✓ All Contracts completely aligned with EC GA and Dutch and EU VAT legislation
- ✓ NREN may facilitate relationships between supplier and local R&E community


Procurement – Driving Adoption Funding





General Principles –

- 1. 2in1 procurements driving adoption from two sides
- introduce R&E community to Cloud Services suppliers in early stage
- 3. Invite supplier to pro-actively approach R&E community to search for projects
- 4. Professional market approach focused on R&E demand
- Using procurements to connect market with R&E community
- 6. Frame R&E demand by using clear set minimum requirements & criteria
- 7. Twofold stimulation: market > EC fund < R&E institutions
- 8. Both supply as demand driven towards EU funding
- 9. Using stakeholders like NREN's & ESA network for scalingup projects to secure returns on investment
- 10. VAT regulations, EU directive and threshold compliance
- 11. OCRE framework to be used for Cloud procurements
- 12. EO services will be multiple/direct awards (below threshold) using OCRE catalogue of EO providers



ADOPTION of Services

"BIG" Mini-competition within OCRE EC Funding for Proposals of research projects





OCRE CLOUD services resellers – be awarded up to €500,000-Driving Adoption of Cloud Services within EU & UK research projects- until remaining EC budget ceiling is completed (taken EO into account).

Minimum requirements like:

- Proven adoption of Cloud Services within research project(s)
- Representing Ethical research
- One proposal per awarded EU or UK lot several projects possible
- No double funding
- Institutions support and on time input for EC report
- Usual mini-competition MR: Vouchers, VAT, Exit plan etc.

Awarding Criterium	Description	Weight (%)
1	Demonstrating the adoption and benefits of Cloud	40%
2	The project plan	20%
3	Sustainability	20%
4	Best value for money	20%

Planning

- Published end April 2022
- ➤ Mol in May 2022
- Deadline submitting Proposals 7 July 2022
- Scoring and awarding July / August
- Sept 2022 standstill and start Projects
- Nov 2022 provide input for EC report

laaS activities and status





- Published on Tenders Electronic Daily (TED)
 on 15 April 2020
- Closing date for submissions was extended to 23
 June 2020, due to the COVID 19 crisis and delayed market response.
- LOT based one supplier of each platform in each country (including hyperscale resellers **).
- Framework contracts signed in Q1 2021
- Awarded contracts made available via TED (publication of outcome) in August 2021
- Continuance EC adoption funded Projects throughout 2022

- ➤ Market response to tender 1100 bids
- ➤ Outcome 473 cloud contracts across 40 lots
- > 37 cloud platforms represented
- Minimum of 9 platforms per country
- Maximum 17 platforms per country
- **➤ GÉANT WP4/CMG contract management**

Other activities and status





- Suppliers of Earth Observation services invited to register on the OCRE EO Catalogue
- First EO Tender published
- First 10 Cloud EC funded mini-competitions published on behalf of awarded institutes (15 in total)
- Suppliers engaged and informed through interactive infosessions stimulating feedback
- Proposals received and evaluated by institutes Awards
- Agreed upon project extension with EC





Adoption funding - Challenges





COMPLIANT procurement on behalf of funding initiative

- GÉANT/partner must procure vouchers on behalf of institutes
- Voucher funding incurs VAT at point of consumption
- Dual VAT could occur for funding awards outside of the EU and UK



- ✓ EY VAT expert opinion has been sought and received, confirming proposed VAT treatment with least risk
- ✓ OCRE funding contracts have been drafted accordingly.
- ✓ Confirmatory rulings from Dutch Tax Authority & EC eligibility

MOVING FORWARD (*Tax ruling received – Imminent*)

- Complete procurement of vouchers for research projects in first calls
- Distribute remaining funding (via cluster projects/dataspaces and other EOSC FUTURE related activities)
- Build compelling case studies







Call of Contract I







- Switching to an entirely new platform is not economically feasible > An existing cloud platform or; > The partner organisation in the use case has already standardised on one platform.
- The service we wish to buy is not available on any other platforms on the Framework.
- The licensing arrangements around our existing platform mean that due to Intellectual Property rights we cannot switch to another provider.



Call of Contract II







- Evaluate all Suppliers in its Lot.
 Exception: if a Supplier is clearly unable to meet a specific requirement, this Supplier may be excluded (see direct award support tool for excluding Suppliers).
- Reuse GÉANT's scores against the offer of the Supplier for the following award criteria (ACs):
 - O AC1 Service and Support
 - O AC2 Marketing and Adoption Support
 - O AC3 Exit Support
 - O AC7 Sustainability
- ➤ Calculate new scores on Price with Online Cost Calculators:
 - O AC4 Price. laaS / PaaS / SaaS discount percentage applied to current prices.
 - o AC6 Price. Additional Services.



Call of Contract III





Option 3: Mini- competition:

- Invite all resellers in the lot to mini-competition making sure to create fair level playing field: equal, transparent and proportional;
- > Apply the award criteria based on needs and requirements, for example:
- Ideal Solution
- Added Value
- Pricing
- Score award stand still period
- ➤ Make an order and sign the call-off contract with awarded Reseller


