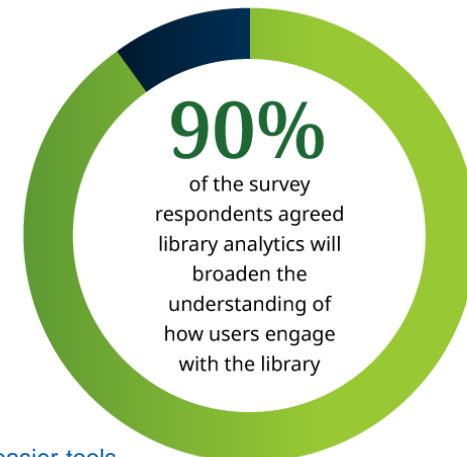

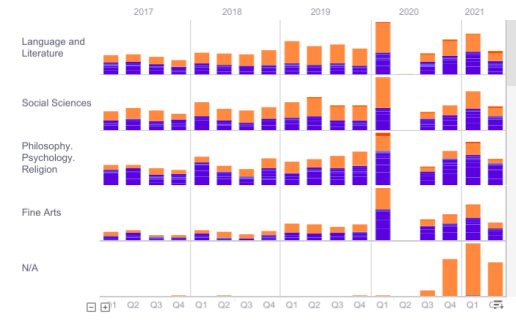
### CIRCULATION BY YEAR OF PUBLISHING

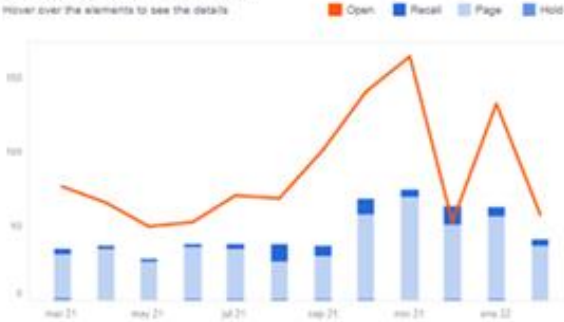

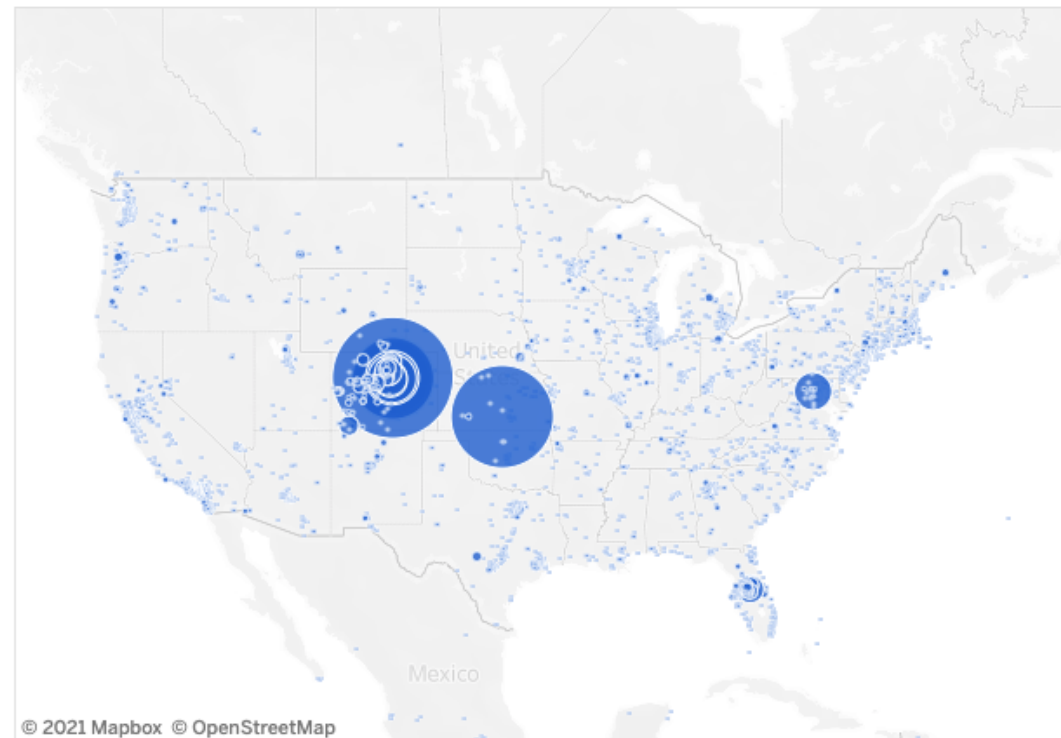

## NUMBER OF SESSIONS BY GEOGRAPHY

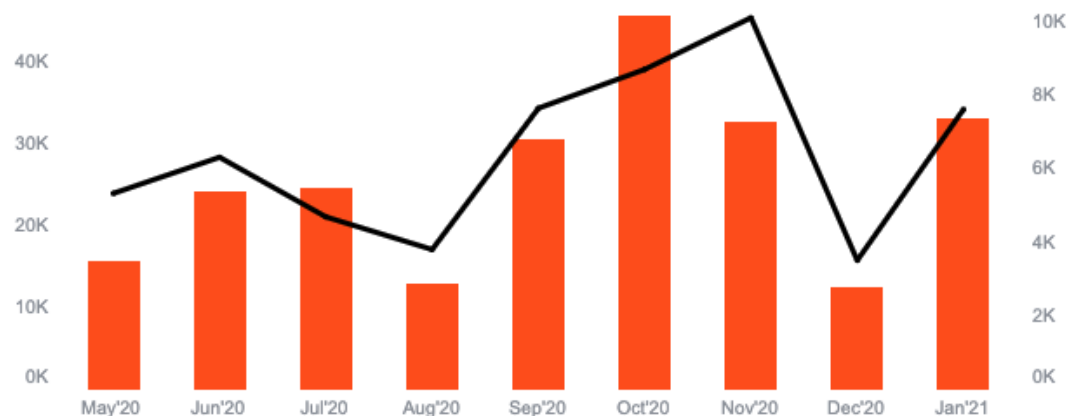

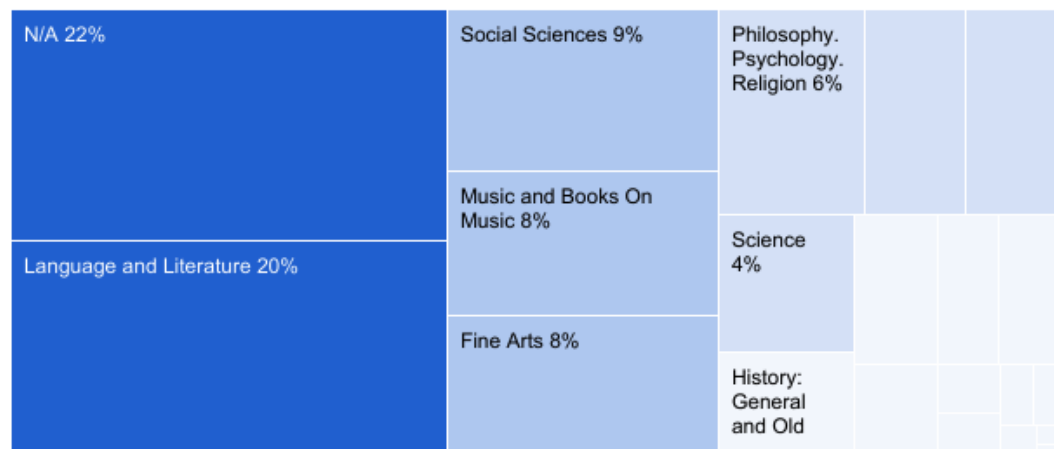
