





Since the 1980 decade, almost 200 anglophone written accounts related to travelling to and around Portugal have been read, annotated, and organised. This close reading methodology resulted in the Anglophone travellers in Portugal database, which gathers an unprecedented and heterogeneous collection of foreign perspectives on Portuguese history, culture, and society, from the 18th to the 20th century.

The Portuguese Vegetarian Society was founded in 1911. Its monthly periodical, *O Vegetariano: Mensário Naturista Ilustrado*, directed by Dr. Amílcar De Sousa and published uninterruptedly between 1909 and 1935, had a community of over 3.500 subscribers. All periodical items, besides other related research and outreach outputs, are indexed in this searchable database.






